Multisystem Care Teams are available to any Franklin County family with a child or youth (age birth through 21 years old) needing help with coordinating services from two or more programs. An agency staff person who is already involved with a family can refer the family for service coordination or a family can refer themselves to Family and Children First Council for a Multisystem Care Team.

MULTISYSTEM CARE TEAMS & YOU

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT FROM FCFC

Multisystem care teams use a collaborative approach to help families with children who have multiple needs. We connect agencies, people and services to work with you to develop a coordinated plan for your child and family. A team approach helps to organize services to better meet the specific and unique needs of your family. We help you get the support you need to achieve the things that are important to you and to your child.

Parents always have the right to:

- Decide who should be part of the child and family team
- Initiate a team meeting
- Be heard in team meetings
- Bring an advocate to team meetings
- Select or decline service options
- Use the Dispute Resolution Process if you do not agree with service decisions.

Our multisystem care team activities include:

- Gathering information to learn about your family
- Identifying individuals that you would like on your team
- Scheduling and facilitating multisystem team meetings to build on your family strengths and identify needed supports
- Helping to create an individualized family plan of care
- Coordinating access to all identified services and supports
- Providing information about advocacy services that are available to you
- Celebrating successes!

HOW WE WORK WITH YOU

Once you connect with Franklin County FCFC, we will meet with you to explain multisystem care teams and to get to know your family's strengths and needs. Through collaboration, we will build your multisystem team and create a unique family plan of care based on your needs.

Throughout our partnership, we will work to help strengthen your family and ensure that your children thrive. This may include teaming with:

- Job & Family Services
- Developmental Disabilities Board
- Mental Health/counseling agencies
- Child Protective Services
- Juvenile Court
- Schools
- Faith communities
- Parenting support
- Mentors
- Health agencies
- Non-profit organizations
- Vocational rehabilitation resources
- Employment resources
- Natural supports (neighbors, friends, extended family, coaches, etc.)
