These resources can support your child's development and provide relief for caregivers. From educational assistance to therapeutic activities, these programs are here to help.

Educational Support: Learning Aid Ohio

[Learning Aid Ohio](#) provides financial assistance to families of students with disabilities, helping them access in-person or virtual tutoring and support services. This program, in partnership with the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities, is designed to enhance learning outcomes and provide additional academic support.

Music Therapy: The Learning Spectrum

[The Learning Spectrum's Music Therapy Program](#) offers children an opportunity to develop communication, social, and emotional skills through music. Music therapy can be a powerful tool for children with special needs, providing a fun and engaging way to learn and express themselves.

Swim Therapy: SafeSplash Columbus-Sawmill South

[SafeSplash Columbus-Sawmill South](#) offers adaptive swim lessons tailored to children with special needs. These lessons help build water safety skills, improve motor function, and increase confidence in a structured and supportive environment.

Summer Program: Buddy Summer Camp

[Buddy Summer Camp](#) provides structured summer programming for children with autism and other developmental disabilities. The program focuses on behavioral intervention and social skills development in a fun, supportive environment.

Tumbling Classes: Integrity Athletics

[Integrity Athletics](#) offers tumbling and trampoline classes designed to improve motor skills, coordination, and confidence. These classes provide a great physical outlet for children with diverse needs in an encouraging setting.

Home Health Aide Support

If you have the county waiver, you can sign up with Boundless PDP to choose one of their trained providers as an aide. Another option is to ask your child's doctor if they can write a prescription for home health aide hours. Then, you can find a home health agency to meet your family's needs.

Tutoring and Family Support: Jeremiah's Corner

[Jeremiah's Corner](#) offers a host of services, classes, and resources for families with disabilities. They are currently accepting more students for one-on-one tutoring.
